

## Running NetInstall on the HandEra 330

***Warning: Running NetInstall may require your OS to be updated, which will wipe out the RAM and flash on your HandEra 330. Make sure to perform a Backup operation to secure the data in your unit.***

### Requirements

- An SD (Secure Digital) or CF (CompactFlash) memory card with sufficient free memory for the NetInstall files. An MMC card is compatible with SD.
- A PC with an SD or CF card reader

### Installation

1. Install fresh alkaline batteries, or fully charge your Lithium Ion pack before beginning the NetInstall process.
2. Download NetInstall.zip file from the web site.
3. Double-click NetInstall.zip. If Windows reports that it is an unsupported file type, you will need to install an application that can uncompress a .ZIP file, such as Winzip (see [www.winzip.com](http://www.winzip.com)).
4. Insert your memory card into an SD or CF card reader connected to your PC. Extract the files in NetInstall.zip into into the ROOT of your memory card, preserving all paths. Make sure you don't remove the memory card while the file is being written. Typically, you will need to perform an EJECT command on the drive associated with the card reader when finished. Consult the documentation included with your card reader for the steps involved in copying files to a memory card.
5. Insert the your memory card into the expansion slot of your HandEra handheld.
6. On your HandEra 330, launch the CardPro app.
7. Inside the CardPro app, select the memory card you just inserted. Navigate to the /PALM/Launcher folder.
8. Tap NetInstall.prc to select it. Then tap the Copy button to copy it to RAM. If an error message is displayed indicating an invalid file, most likely the memory card was removed from the SD or CF reader before the files had been completely copied. Repeat step 4.
9. Launch NetInstall app. Follow the onscreen instructions.
